

**TEXAS PROFESSIONAL EDUCATIONAL DIAGNOSTICIANS
BOARD OF REGISTRY**

The following are the requirements to become a Registered Professional Educational Diagnostician:

1. Be at least 21 years of age.
2. Have completed a certification program acceptable to the Board in the field of educational diagnostic services at an educational institution approved by the Board, or the equivalent as determined acceptable by the Board.
3. Have the minimum full-time teaching experience required by the certification board or agency of the State of Texas in a manner acceptable to the Board.
4. Hold Professional or Standard Certification by the State Board of Educator Certification as an Educational Diagnostician, or the equivalent as determined by the Board.
5. Have two years (at least 18 months) of full-time experience (at least 40 hours per week) as an Educational Diagnostician, four years (at least 36 months) of part-time experience (at least 20 hours per week), or an equivalent amount of experience as determined by the Board, following receipt of Standard Certification as an Educational Diagnostician.
6. Submit to the Board a completed application for registration as prescribed by the Board and such other information as the Board may require.
7. Take the examination for Registry.
8. Comply with standards of conduct and competency adopted by the Board.
9. Pay to the Board any fees set by the Board.
